TCS REGISTRATION FORM

Tibetan Culture School, an educational program of Tibetan American Foundation of Minnesota (TAFM) was founded in 1997 by its members. The mission of this Culture School is to enable the Tibetan children to learn their language, history, religion and cultural Heritage. The academic year is from the first Saturday in September to the last Saturday in June. The Tibetan Culture School operates from our Saint Paul Center every Saturday from 9:00 am to 1:00 pm.

Enrollment Window: Saturday, March 1, 2026 – June 30, 2026

Late applications will be accepted from July 1 to July 31 with a late fee of \$25.00 per child. No application will be accepted after July 31 unless a student has moved to MN from other states/countries.

Eligibility: Your child is eligible to enroll in kindergarten for the fall of 2026 if the child turns six on or before September 1, 2026.

Important Information for Parents

1. Tuition is \$350 for children of TAFM members who are up to date on their membership dues; else the tuition is \$650. The third enrolled child is free.
2. For NEW enrollees, there is a registration fee of \$10 per child.
3. Parents / Student shall make their own arrangements for transportation to and from TCC.
4. REFUND POLICY: A full tuition refund will be issued if the cancellation request is submitted during the first month (Registration and late fee will NOT be refunded). After the first month, refunds will be based on how many months students will not attend (\$30/month for children who paid \$350, and \$60/month for all others).
5. ATTN: All parents of TCS Students are automatically part of the Parents Committee and one of the parents must participate/volunteer shift in the safety and well-being events on Saturday from 9 am - 12 pm. If neither parent is able to attend, they must find a substitute or pay a \$50 fine. Parents who are current TAFM board members, current teachers, staff, for either TCS, preschool, or kids club are exempted.
6. All students are encouraged to wear traditional chupa during school days.
